### CLAY

#### **Wheel Pottery Class**

Get your hands dirty and make beautiful things! Start with centering clay and pulling cylinders, the building blocks to throwing on the wheel. Move on to forming bowls, mugs, vases and plates, and learn handle-pulling, glazing and finishing techniques. Open to beginners as well as those with experience who would like to improve their skills.

When you get home, just pre-chill it in the freezer before your guests arrive – the pottery holds the cold temperature, so no ice is necessary.

### **Summer Crafts**

**Pineapple Lanterns** Using felt, tissue paper and markers turn a mason jar into a tropical pineapple. We will provide a tealight to add a warm glow to this charming lantern. \$10
